Eligibility

Deputy Heads who are aspiring to headship and meet the following criteria:

- Looking to gain a headship role in the next 12-18 months
- Completed at least one year at Deputy Head level or Senior Leadership Team
- Evidence of having made substantial positive impact on a school or
- Those currently in headship roles

NPQH Programme

The main focus of this programme is to ensure all participants increase their confidence and capability in the core skills and responsibilities of an effective school leader.

The course will empower participants to develop a strong network to support them as head teachers.

The programme will consist of 6 face to face full day sessions led by two experienced facilitators who are both current serving senior leaders, held at Birmingham locations.

All participants will need to complete 2 assessed pieces of work – one at their own setting and one at the placement school. All participants will need to organise and undertake a 9 day placement at another contrasting school setting to complete the qualification.
