NPQSL Programme

The main focus of this programme is the participant's own leadership development including how to make the best use of tasks and tools to make the transition to senior leadership.

The programme will consist of 4 full days and 1 half day face to face sessions. The programme is led by two experienced facilitators who are both current serving senior leaders, held at Birmingham locations.

All participants will be assessed through a written assignment focussing on an inschool impact project to ensure they have reached the qualification requirements.
