Communities; you are split into groups of 3 to 4. Everyone in the group will have the opportunity to share a 'tricky' professional problem that they are currently facing in their role in school. The other members of the group will offer challenge and support using the learning from the modules (and beyond) to help resolve the tricky problem. A chair person will be set by the group, prior to the next community session.
